Learning outcomes

To understand how type 1 diabetes occurs in the body.

To understand the meaning of words associated with type 1 diabetes.

To explain to others what type 1 diabetes is.

Tasks

Share the following explanation of type 1 diabetes with the group:

Type 1 diabetes is a condition where the body is unable to regulate blood-glucose levels as the pancreas does not make enough insulin.

Discuss with the group what their understanding of type 1 diabetes is and explain that they will be focussing on finding out more about type 1 diabetes.

To research the meaning of the highlighted words and understand how they relate to type 1 diabetes.

To create a diagram, image, PowerPoint presentation, animation, film or short physical action/play to explain to someone what type 1 diabetes is and how it affects the body.

Students should make sure they include:
