

Key Stage 1 Science

Introducing and understanding type 1 diabetes through science.

Resources required

- Type 1 Diabetes Made Simple interactive book.
- Pupil task sheets 1 and 2 Science: One copy per child.
- KS1 Science Presentation

Learning outcomes

Children are able to list and identify the main external parts of the body and recognise the similarities and differences between themselves and others.

Task

- Introduce the concept of major organs in relation to their position in the body:

Head - Where is my brain? What does my brain help me to do?

Chest - Where is my heart? What does my heart do?

Chest - Where are my lungs? What do my lungs help me to do?

Torso - Where is my stomach? What does my stomach do?

Whole body - Where does my blood go?

Whole body - What helps me to keep standing up?

- Talk about the function of the stomach and where it is located in the body.

Pupil task

- Ask pupils to name the main parts of the body and put them in the correct order to build a person.
